
Re: Binding Letter of Intent for the Current Hancock Bank Property, Picayune, Mississippi

Dear Messrs. Luke and Lawler:

This Binding letter of Intent (the "Letter") evidences the intent of Mississippi Power Company ("MPC"), the City of Picayune (the "City") and the Pearl River County Utility Authority (the "Authority") to relocate certain utility services and vacate a portion of an unimproved dedicated alley on the former Whitney Bank property in Picayune, Mississippi more particularly described and shown in the survey attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (the "Property"). Following, and subject to, the purchase of the Property by MPC, the undersigned parties hereby agree to perform, or cause to be performed, the following:

1. The City agrees to move any utility service facilities/equipment, including, but not limited to water service, located in the area marked "Alley" on the attached Exhibit "A";
2. Any such utility service facilities/equipment shall be relocated (i.e. moved), at MPC's sole cost and expense, to an area chosen by the City; provided, however, that the service shall be relocated solely within the fifteen foot (15') easement bordering the Property and being labeled "15' Easement" on the attached Exhibit "A";
3. Subsequent to the relocation of such utility service facilities/equipment the City agrees to vacate that certain area marked "Alley" on the attached Exhibit "A" upon the filing of an application for such vacation by MPC in accordance with applicable laws, ordinances and regulations;
4. Contemporaneously with the vacation of the area marked "Alley" on the attached Exhibit "A", MPC shall grant an easement, upon mutually acceptable terms and conditions, to the Authority for the Authority's utility service facilities/equipment, including, but not limited to sewer service, located in the area marked "Alley" on the attached Exhibit "A"; and
5. The Authority shall make any alterations, at MPC's sole cost and expense, to the Authority's utility service facilities/equipment to accommodate the easement.

This Letter is intended to impose legally binding obligations on MPC, the City and the Authority; provided, however, that such obligations shall be subject to the condition precedent that MPC


