

ORDINANCE NUMBER 908

OF THE

CITY OF PICAYUNE, MISSISSIPPI

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH THE TIME AND PLACE FOR THE REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS the City Council in and for the City of Picayune formerly met at 5:00 p.m. at 815 North Beech Street, Picayune, Mississippi.

WHEREAS it is the desire of the present City Council to change the meeting location from 815 North Beech Street, Picayune, Mississippi, to 203 Goodyear Boulevard, Picayune, Mississippi, for the regular public meetings of the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Picayune, that all prior Ordinances of the Municipal Code, including but not limited to Ordinance No. 742 and Ordinance No. 868, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

SECTION - ONE

Regular public meetings of the mayor and council of the City of Picayune shall be held on the first Tuesday of each month at the hour of 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers 203 Goodyear Boulevard, Picayune, Mississippi.

SECTION - TWO

SEVERABILITY, CONFLICT AND EFFECTIVE DATE

Should any section, clause, paragraph, provision, or part of this Ordinance for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, this act shall not affect the validity or any other section, clause, paragraph, provision, or part of this ordinance. All provision of this Ordinance shall be considered separate provision, and completely severable from all other portions.

Conflict in any case where a provision of this ordinance is found to be in conflict with the provision of any other ordinance or code of the City of Picayune, Mississippi, existing on the effective date of this Ordinance, the provisions of this Ordinance shall take precedence.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its adoption and publication by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Picayune, Pearl River County, Mississippi.

The foregoing Ordinance, having first been reduced to writing, was moved upon by Council member Watkins, seconded by Council member Gouguet, and voted upon as follows:
