**PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY
BY MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PICAYUNE**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Picayune does hereby find that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen with said City of Picayune caused by **Flash Flooding** commencing on or about 6:30 am, March 11, 2016 and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency in order to provide for the health and safety of the citizens and the protection of their property within the affected jurisdiction;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that in accordance with Section 33-15-17(d), Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended a local emergency now exists throughout said City of Picayune and shall be reviewed every seven (7) days until such local emergency is no longer in effect and proclaimed terminated by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Picayune, State of Mississippi.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that all City agencies and departments shall render all possible assistance and discharge their emergency responsibilities as set forth in the City of Picayune Emergency Operations Plan.




