WATER RATES:

RESIDENTIAL - INSIDE CITY LIMITS

First 3,000 gallons or less \$18.50 (Minimum)

All in excess of 3,000 gallons \$3.25 per 1,000 gal.

RESIDENTIAL - OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS

First 3,000 gallons or less \$33.00 (Minimum)

All in excess of 3,000 gallons \$4.75 per 1,000 gal.

COMMERCIAL - INSIDE CITY LIMITS

First 3,000 gallons or less \$22.00 (Minimum)

All in excess of 3,000 gallons \$3.25 per 1,000 gal.

COMMERCIAL – OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS

First 3,000 gallons or less \$33.00 (Minimum)

All in excess of 3,000 gallons \$4.75 per 1,000 gal.

INDUSTRIAL

First 5,000 gallons or less \$41.00 (Minimum)

All in excess of 5,000 gallons \$3.15 per 1,000 gal.

PUBLIC AUTHORITY

First 3,000 gallons or less \$22.00 (Minimum)
All in excess of 3,000 gallons \$3.15 per 1,000 gal.

SPRINKLER

First 3,000 gallons or less \$17.00 (Minimum)
All in excess of 3,000 gallons \$3.50 per 1,000 gal.

First 1,000 cubic foot or less \$ 11.25
All in excess of 1,000 cubic feet \$ 11.00 per MMBtu

** This Purchased Gas Adjustment Rider shall be applicable to all sales rates of the City. The amount computed under any of the City’s natural gas sales rates may be adjusted by adding thereto any increases or subtracting therefrom any decrease in the cost of gas to the City from its base cost of \$3.09 per MCF.

The sum of gas is defined as the sum of the city’s cost per MMbtu from the supplier, plus transportation, plus the value per Mmbtu of unaccounted loss, plus the cost per MMbtu of consulting services.
