APPROVE REQUEST TO DECLARE A STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO HURRICANE IDA


Motion was made by Council Member Breland, seconded by Council Member Turnage to Declare a State of Emergency within the City of Picayune due to Hurricane Ida.


